STATEMENT OF EMERGENCY

HSC Regulation No. 015 P.P.E.. Moratorium on new applications for hospice facilities and hospice agencies subject to Permit of Approval review.

This emergency administrative regulation addresses a moratorium on the acceptance of a new Permit of Approval categories entitled hospice facilities and hospice agencies while the Health Services Commission develops appropriate criteria for the review of such services. The Commission finds that the imminent peril to the public, health, safety, or welfare requires adoption of this rule to be effective immediately upon filing on September 26, 1997 since an Emergency Clause in Act 396 of 1997 makes these facilities/agencies subject to review immediately. The Commission needs an adopted methodology upon which to review this type of service in place prior to the acceptance of applications. This regulation will be replaced with an ordinary administrative regulation.

Emergency Rule.

Moratorium on the acceptance of hospice facility/hospice agency application materials or the placing of hospice facility/hospice agency applications under Permit of Approval review. For the time period commencing September 26, 1997 and ending January 24, 1998 (or 120 days) a Moratorium exists in order for the Health Services Commission to develop and adopt criteria for the review of such services prior to the acceptance of applications. (This Moratorium does not apply to those entities that have filed written intent to build a hospice facility or operate a hospice agency prior to the effective date of Act 396 of 1997 (March 7, 1997).)
