7	SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Rule is to promulgate
8	guidelines for the voluntary establishment of reserves for funeral
9	expense insurance as referenced in Ark. Code Ann. §23-64-206 (g) (8), and
10	defined in the Commissioner's Rule and Regulation 30.
11	SECTION 2. AUTHORITY. This Rule is promulgated pursuant to the
12	Commissioner's authority under Ark. Code Ann. §23-61-108, and §23-63-106,
13	§23-64-206 and §§25-15-201, et seq.
14	SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS. (a) "Funeral expense insurance" is that form of
15	insurance as defined in the Commissioner's Rule and Regulation 30,
16	"Funeral Expense Insurance". (b) "Insurer" as used in this Rule is any
17	authorized life insurer, fraternal benefit society, stipulated premium insurer or mutual assessment life insurer.
18	insurer or mutual assessment life insurer.
19	SECTION 4. RESERVES. Subject to the prior written approval of the
20	Insurance Commissioner, any life insurer licensed and doing business in
21	this State and still having outstanding and in force funeral expense
22	contracts issued prior to January 1, 1968 or reinsured thereafter, which
23	contracts provide for payment of death benefits by furnishing goods,
24	services or merchandise or cash, may over a reasonable number of years
25	establish reserves on such contracts. Subject to prior written approval
26	of the Insurance Commissioner, amounts for the reserves on such contracts
27	shall be calculated by using: (a) mortality tables recognized by the
28	Society of Actuaries or by similar organizations; and (b) current
29	interest rate assumptions. Upon establishment, such reserves shall
30	thereafter be maintained unimpaired by the insurer unless lesser
31	aggregate reserves are subsequently approved in writing by the
32	Commissioner upon the insurer's written application. To secure the Commissioner's approval for a cash reserve plan under this Rule, the
33 34	insurer must pay cash benefits for policy claims.

36	SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. The effective date of this Rule shall be
37	August 1, 1994 upon and after filing with the Arkansas Secretary of State
