REGULATION 2(8)

REQUIRING MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING PHYSICIAN/PATIENT RELATIONSHIPS

A physician exhibits gross negligence if he provides and/or recommends any form of treatment, including prescribing legend drugs, without first establishing a proper physician/patient relationship.

Section A. For purposes of this regulation a proper physician/patient relationship, at a minimum requires that:

- 1. The physician perform a history and physical examination of the patient adequate to establish a diagnosis and identify underlying conditions and/or contraindications to the treatment recommended/provided, OR personally knows the patient and the patient's general health status through an "ongoing" personal or professional relationship, AND THAT
- 2. Appropriate follow-up be provided, when necessary, at medically necessary intervals.

Section B. Exceptions

- 1. Emergency situations where the life or health of the patient is in danger or imminent danger.
- 2. Treatment provided in consultation with, or upon referral by, another physician who has an ongoing relationship with the patient, and who has agreed to supervise the patient's treatment, including follow-up care and the use of any prescribed medications.
- 3. On-call or cross-coverage situations in which the physician has access to patient records.
- 4. Simply providing information of a general or generic nature not meant to be specific to an individual patient.
