## NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE AMENDMENT

The Arkansas Real Estate Commission will hold a Public Hearing at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, August 11, 2014 in the Meeting Room of the Arkansas Real Estate Commission building, 612 South Summit Street, Little Rock, Arkansas for the purpose of receiving public or written comment on the adoption of proposed amendments to existing regulations pertaining to the practice of real estate in the state of Arkansas. Subjects and issues involved are as follows:

"Regulation 4.1 and Section 11"-This proposed rule updates education requirements for applicants for real estate broker licensure to include a forty-five classroom hour pre-licensing course developed by the Real Estate Commission pursuant to Act 281 of 2013; update regulations to reflect changes in the regulation of real estate education by the Real Estate Commission pursuant to Act 281 of 2013; and removes out-of-date regulation that no longer applies to the broker post-license course developed by the Real Estate Commission that new brokers must complete within twelve months of obtaining a broker license.
