## **Notice of Rulemaking**

The Arkansas Veterinary Medical Examining Board hereby issues the following proposed amendments to its Rules pursuant to its authority under Ark. Code Ann. §§ 17-101-203 and 17-101-316.

Pursuant to Act 1074 of the 91st General Assembly (2017), the Rules of the Arkansas Veterinary Medical Examining Board are being updated to include a certification for individuals who engage in livestock embryo transfer or transplant and livestock pregnancy determination. This rule will define certain terms found within the Act, as well as govern the application process, renewal process, continuing education requirements, and record keeping requirements for the certification.
