Arkansas Workers' Compensation Commission December 4, 2014 Notice of Public Hearing and Rule Making

Pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act codified at Ark. Code Ann. 25-15-201 et seq and the Arkansas Workers' Compensation Law codified at Ark. Code Ann. 11-9-101 et seq, notice is hereby given that the Arkansas Workers' Compensation Commission (Commission) is proposing to modify an existing rule. The following paragraph contains the newly proposed additions to amend Rule 099.30.

AMENDED RULE 099.30 MEDICAL COST CONTAINMENT PROGRAM

- t. Establishes Medical Treatment Guidelines.
- **u**. Establish a Drug Formulary

T. Treatment Guidelines

Effective January 15, 2015, the scope and duration of the medical treatment under workers' compensation shall be provided in accordance with the current edition of Official Disability Guidelines (ODG), as published by the Work Loss Data Institute. Medical treatment provided by or at the direction of the treating physician in accordance with ODG is presumed to be reasonable and necessary and not subject to utilization review. The employer or insurance carrier shall not be responsible for charges for medical treatment that is not provided in accordance with the ODG unless (1) it was provided in a medical emergency, (2) it was preauthorized by the employer or insurance carrier, or (3) it was approved by the Workers' Compensation Commission upon a finding based on clear and convincing evidence provided by or at the direction of the treating physician. Medications with the Status of N in the ODG Drug Formulary require preauthorization.

U. Drug Formulary

The Full Commission hereby adopts the ODG Workers' Compensation Drug Formulary. For workers' compensation claims with a date of injury on or after July 1, 2015, the closed formulary applies to all drugs that are prescribed and dispensed for outpatient use as of July 1, 2015. For legacy claims with a date of injury before July 1, 2015, the closed formulary applies to all drugs that are prescribed and dispensed for outpatient use as of July 1, 2016. Under the closed formulary, preauthorization is required for all drugs with Status N in the ODG.
