

## NOTICE OF RULEMAKING

Pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, notice is hereby given that the State Board of Election Commissioners (Board) is proposing amendments to:

- Rules for Reimbursement of Expenses For State-Funded Elections (effective February 6, 2004) that set forth amended procedures for reimbursing counties for election expenses related to state-funded elections;
- Rules for Election Officials (Poll Workers) Training (effective March 17, 2002) that set forth amended procedures for statewide training of local election officials (poll workers);
- Rules for County Election Commissioners Training (effective December 1, 2005) that set forth amended procedures for statewide training of county election commissioners;
- Rules for Voter Intent (effective April 14, 2002) that set forth amended procedures for determining voter intent;
- Rules on Provisional Voting (effective April 22, 2006) that set forth amended procedures for issuing, processing, and counting provisional ballots;
- Rules for Nonpartisan Judicial Office Filing Fees (effective February 17, 2002) that set forth amended procedures for establishing filing fees for nonpartisan judicial offices; and
- Rules for Citizen Complaints of Non-HAVA (Help America Vote Act) Violations of Election and Voter Registration Laws (effective February 6, 2004) that set forth the procedures for providing resolution of non-HAVA related complaints.
