Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held at the offices of the Arkansas Development Finance Authority (ADFA), 900 West Capital Building Suite 310, Little Rock, Arkansas 72201, at 10:30 a.m., Thursday, September 29, 2011, to discuss significant changes to the 2012 Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP) and Minimum Design Standard.

Summary of 2012 Qualified Allocation Plan and Minimum Design Standard Changes

- 1. Designation of 30% basis boost to counties in which a tax credit award has not been made in the past three (3) years, identified in the 2012 QAP, and to developments funded in part by Rural Development.
- 2. Remove Energy Star requirement; maintain HERS requirements; sampling permissible.
- 3. Operating Reserve can be decreased by 50% upon meeting specified benchmarks and a personal guaranty by acceptable person or entity.
- 4. Reduce points available for location in QCT to 5. Provide 10 points for location in counties that have not had a tax credit award in past 3 years.
- 5. Rehabilitation developments eligible for energy points based upon degree of HERS rating improvement.
- 6. Three times the Non-Compliance score calculated by the Compliance Department, based upon issued 8823's for previous year, will be deducted from application score, up to 15 points.

Minimum Design Standards

- 1. General contractor must sign off on Attachment G prior to issuance of the Notice to Proceed.
- 2. "Cementious prefinished" added as permissible option for prefinished fascia and soffit.
- 3. Change roof requirement from a 25-year warranty to a 30-year warranty.
- 4. Require tamper-proof fire alarms.
- 5. U-Factor of not greater than 0.35 (changed from 0.39) and a solar heat gain coefficient (SHGC) of not greater than 0.30 (changed from 0.37).
- 6. Remove Energy Star requirement; retain HERS rating requirements for new construction.
