## **Notice of Public Hearing**

- ADFA and the Arkansas Economic Development Commission Arkansas Energy Office (AEDC AEO) will assign a team (staff from those agencies) to develop fact sheets, review the requests for allocations and make recommendations to the Volume Cap Review Committee which is the Directors of ADFA, AEDC and the Department of Finance and Administration. The Committee will then make the final allocation determinations;
- ADFA will perform the duties of administrator.
