## Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission

The Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission is proposing amendments to its rules as follows:

<u>Brucellosis in Cattle</u>: A proposed new rule will combine four current rules, which will allow for the repeal of four brucellosis rules.

<u>Trichomoniasis Testing and Movement for Cattle</u>: Amendments to the current rule include a change to the length of time in which cattle may stay at a livestock auction after sale.

<u>Feral Hog Airborne Eradication Rule</u>: A proposed new rule outlines the process for obtaining a permit to hunt feral hogs from aircraft.
