NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to Arkansas Act 371 of 2007, and Arkansas Code Ann. §§25-15-201 et seq., and other applicable Arkansas laws, NOTICE is hereby given that a PUBLIC HEARING will be held on **Monday, December 3, 2007, at 10:00 a. m.**, in the Arkansas State Police Commission Room, Department of the Arkansas State Police ("Department"), located in Little Rock, Arkansas, at 1 State Police Plaza Drive, at the intersection of I-30 and Geyer Springs.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to receive public comments on the captioned new Rules; the purpose of the Rules is to set guidelines for conformity with Arkansas Act 371 of 2007, to ensure the orderly patrol of controlled-access facilities by municipal police departments listed by the Director for orderly and appropriate law enforcement assistance to the Arkansas State Police patrols. Proposed effective date is **January 1, 2008**.

All interested persons are encouraged to attend the ASP Public Hearing and may appear and present, orally or in writing, statements or arguments or opinions on the Proposed Rules.
