

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE MAKING

Highway Patrol Division

In compliance with the Arkansas Administrative Procedures Act, notice is hereby given that the Department of Arkansas State Police intends to adopt a new Non-Commercial Driver's License Testing Rule and amend the current Arkansas State Police Commercial Driver's License Testing Rule 2.1, which were effective October 15, 2007, as follows:

Create Rule 1 Arkansas Non-commercial Driver's License Testing Rule concerning establishing a period of time a person must wait before retest after an unsuccessful attempt to take the non-commercial driver's license test; and

Amend the current Commercial Driver's License Testing Rule 2.1 to provide for the expiration of the commercial driver's license application form.
