NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

"Residential Daycare Exception to Automatic Fire-Extinguishing System Requirement"

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Ann. §§ 25-15-201 et seq., and other applicable Arkansas laws, NOTICE is hereby given that the Department of Arkansas State Police intends to modify two (2) provisions of the Arkansas Fire Prevention Code to create an exception to automatic fire-extinguishing system requirements for residential daycares. Specifically, Section 609.2 and Section 904.2 will be revised.
