

Proposed amendments to the "STATE OF ARKANSAS APPRAISER
LICENSING AND CERTIFICATION BOARD RULES AND REGULATIONS
(EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010)"

The current Section XI(A)(5) of the Board's Rules and Regulations would be stricken in its entirety. To be stricken:

5. A certified appraiser who is otherwise qualified for supervising trainees who has been disciplined by the Board could be subject to one or more of the following according to the nature and severity of the violation;
 - (a) Prohibited from supervising a trainee;
 - (b) A restriction placed on the number of trainees that he/she may supervise; and/or:
 - (c) Be required to take additional courses approved by the Board before being permitted to supervise a trainee.

A new Section XI(A)(5) would be inserted. To be inserted:

5. The supervising State Certified Appraiser shall be in good standing and not subject to any disciplinary action within the last three (3) years that affects their ability to practice.

As recommended by the Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board at its meeting on February 7, 2013.
