This letter is to notify you that, the Executive Subcommittee exercised the power granted to it under Arkansas Code § 10-3-309(d)(2)(B) and ALC Rule 22(f)(2)(B) to review and approve emergency rules in writing on March 18, 2020. The following emergency rule was reviewed and approved, and the review and approval was effective at 12:00 noon, Friday, March 20, 2020:

• Dept. of Labor and Licensing, Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board, an emergency rule to revise the Appraisal Management Company Rules for compliance with the Federal Financial Institutions Reform, Recovery and Enforcement Act – The Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board of the Arkansas Department of Labor and Licensing is proposing an emergency rule concerning Appraisal Management Company National Registry fees. Each state agency with an appraiser certifying and licensing agency is required to collect and remit the fee pursuant to 12 USCS § 3338(a)(4)(B). In Arkansas, the Appraisal Management Company Registration Act authorizes the Board to set the amount and method of calculation of the fee by rule [See Ark. Code Ann. § 17-14-406(d)(2)]; collect the fee [See Ark. Code Ann. § 17-14-406(d)(1)]; and remit the fee to the Appraisal Subcommittee of the Federal financial Institutions Examination Council. [See Ark. Code Ann. § 17-14-406(f)].

A copy of the emergency rules are attached for your information.

Appraisal Management Company Rules Section V(A), Appraisal Management Company National Registry Fees

Section V (A) - Appraisal Management Company National Registry fees

- A. An appraisal management company shall annually submit to the Board on February 28 an annual appraisal management company national registry fee that is determined by the Appraisal Subcommittee on a form provided by the Board.
- B. The fee will be based on the number of appraisers who have performed an appraisal for the appraisal management company on a covered transaction in Arkansas during January 1 to December 31 of the previous year. The calculations are as follows.
 - 1. If the appraisal management company has been existence for more than a year, twenty-five dollars (\$25) multiplied by the number of appraisers who have performed an appraisal for the appraisal management company on a covered transaction in Arkansas during the previous year; and
 - 2. If the appraisal management company has not been in existence for more than a year, twenty-five dollars (\$25) multiplied by the number of appraisers who have performed an appraisal for the appraisal management company on a covered transaction in Arkansas since the appraisal management company commenced doing business.
- C. The fee will also apply to appraisal management companies that are subsidiaries of Federal Financial Institutions that are exempt from state regulation but are subject to the national registry fees.
- D. If the report and fees are not paid by February 28 of each calendar year, the appraisal management company will be placed on inactive status on the Appraisal Management Company National Registry.
- E. A late fee of fifty dollars (\$50) must be paid for each month or partial month the form and appraisal management company national registry fees are delinquent.
- F. The Appraisal Management Company national registry fees collected will be remitted to the Appraisal Subcommittee as invoiced.

Emergency Clause: It is found by the Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board that federal law requires the notice, calculation, collection and remittance of an Appraisal Management Company National Registry fee. In order to do this in a timely manner, the adoption of this emergency rule is necessary. Any delay in the remittance of the National Registry fee would be detrimental to the economic development of the state and could endanger the ability of Arkansas appraisal management companies to perform appraisals for federal financial institutions and their federally related financial transactions. This rule is therefore necessary to protect against that imminent peril to the public welfare.
