

## NOTICE OF RULEMAKING

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 25-15-201 et seq., notice is hereby given that the Arkansas Fire Protection Licensing Board is proposing new rules and regulations for Sprinkler Systems and Portable and Fixed Systems.

The proposed rules would clarify some previously ambiguous wording, correct typographical errors, raise the minimum amount of liability insurance to national standard levels and allow for a new fitter licensure category as laid out in ACT 743.
