OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

In accordance with A.C.A. § 25-15-204, the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Board invites public comment on revisions to the Arkansas Cadastral Mapping Standard. The Cadastral Mapping Standard was first promulgated as a state rule July 2, 2004, and this data standard is intended to make digital cadastral data more uniform and to facilitate the sharing of a statewide seamless tax parcel spatial data layer. These data are created locally by individual counties then shared with the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems (GIS) Office for publication into an aggregated collection of the whole state. Therefore, it is essential for all those involved in the process to utilize a common structure.

The opportunity to comment ends 30 days following the final date of publication of this legal notice in the Arkansas Democrat Gazette. The publication date of this legal notice in the newspaper of record is the exclusive means for calculating the time to submit written comments regarding the proposed revision.
