State Plant Board Quarterly Meeting and Public Hearing

The Arkansas State Plant Board will meet at 1:30 p.m., March 13, 2012 at the State Plant Board offices, #1 Natural Resources, Drive, Little Rock, AR.

1. Public Hearing. This public hearing will be for the purpose of considering changes to the Pink Boll Worm regulations, contained in Plant Board Circular 16. The proposed changes will add language to the regulations stipulating that any burning activity performed in an effort to meet the Pink Boll Worm regulations must be done in a manner that is in compliance with regulations of EPA, Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality and any other regulatory agency that has responsibilities in meeting the Clean Air Act. Additionally, the inspection fee for additional inspections needed after the deadline for meeting the Pink Boll Worm regulations will be adjusted from \$15, established in 1972, to \$50.
