1. **Public Hearing.** The hearing will be to consider changes to the Arkansas Regulations on Pesticide Classification.


The hearing will be to consider changes to current regulations for Dow Agro Sciences' Enlist Duo in order to add the pesticide Enlist One under the same restrictions.
