Arkansas Natural Resources Commission

The Arkansas Natural Resources Commission is proposing Rules Implementing Act 605 of 2021.

The purpose of the proposed rule is to:

- Outline a process for determining water provider boards found to be in fiscal distress;
- Require boards to conduct a rate study every five years, outline the content of the rate studies, and monitoring the implementation of the rate studies; and
