The Arkansas Department of Parks, Heritage and Tourism announces for a public comment period of thirty (30) calendar days a notice of rulemaking for the following proposed rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters, subchapters, or sections of the Arkansas Code: §§ 22-4-305, 22-4-310, 27-51-1702; 27-51-1703 to 1706, and Act 170 of 1937.

Arkansas State Parks proposed Park directive 2000 Calendar Year 2021 Fees and Rates and Park Directive 3097 Pedal Assist and Electric Bicycles. A public meeting will be held at 10:00 am on October 30, 2020, in the Parks Conference Room, 1 Capitol Mall Suite 4B-206, Little Rock, AR 72201. The public is invited to attend the meeting to provide oral comments.
