OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

In accordance with A.C.A. § 25-15-204, the Division of Land Surveys of the Arkansas GIS Office invites public comment on revisions to the Standards of Practice No.1: Arkansas Standards of Practice for Property Boundary Surveys and Plats. This rule was first promulgated in 1982 and the latest revision was in 2009. The purpose of this rule is to set minimum accuracies for land boundary surveys and minimum requirements for research, investigation, monumentation, and plat preparation, and the subsequent recording and distribution of the plat upon completion of a survey for the purpose of safeguarding public and private land interest. Revising the existing rule is an effort to modernize it and gain efficiencies through clarifications to the filing requirements and survey plat preparation.

The opportunity to comment ends 30 days following the final date of publication of this legal notice in the Arkansas Democrat Gazette. The publication date of this legal notice in the newspaper of record is the exclusive means for calculating the time to submit written comments regarding the proposed revision.
