## **Notice of Rulemaking**

The Arkansas Professional Bail Bond Licensing Board hereby issue the following proposed amendments to its Rules pursuant to its authority under Ark. Code Ann. §§ 17-19-106 and 17-19-108.

The Board is amending its existing rules to provide for the criminal background process mandated by Ark. Code Ann. § 17-3-101 *et seq.*; to update rules to provide for Automatic Licensure of Active Duty Service Members, Returning Military Veterans, and Spouses per Ark. Code Ann. § 17-1-106; to clarify the reciprocity process per Acts 1011/426 of 2019; and to remove the term "Regulation" per Act 315 of 2019.

In addition, following Legislative review of the Board's rules pursuant to Act 781 of the 91<sup>st</sup> General Assembly (2017), the Board is amending its rules to remove several sections that appeared to not be supported by statutory authority or that exceed statutory authority: Section 11 concerning Unsecured Bail Bonds; Section 16(c) concerning a requirement that an agent be physically present when bonding a defendant; Section 16(D) concerning who may be employed by a bail bond company; portions of Section 21 concerning guidelines for financial statements reported to the Board; and Section 27A.(4) concerning how a bail bond company is to cease operations due to unpaid bond forfeitures outstanding.
